We didn't think this incredible news was possible at first: **Ukraine celebrated Christ-mas with us!** The head of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church aligned Christmas with the West for 2022, and Ukrainians celebrated Christmas with us!

On the chronology of the events in the SI Club Lviv/Lviv: On November 29, the Lviv Soroptimists celebrated their first club meeting in a long time – on the 1st Advent, as we noted afterwards.

The transport arrives in Lviv on December 24

And on December 24, just in time for Christmas, the 40-ton truck of Dr. Jürg Streuli's Ukraine Aid arrived in Lviv. Urgently needed generators for the orphanage Lychvchicy could be delivered and made available on loan. The next transport with fixed generators will take place in the second half of January. The financing and organization of the supply chain of ten devices with accessories by us, the SI Union Switzerland, is underway!

What joy; we forget the trouble and the procurement worries! We would like to take this opportunity to thank you here in Switzerland for your great willingness to help and Jürg Streuli and his Ukraine aid team in Switzerland and Ukraine for their cooperation; often possibilities for help are carried out completely quickly – in accordance with the war.

Despite all the joy of Christmas together in Ukraine and in Europe, we must not forget: There is still a cruel war! Nataliya wrote on 23 December 2022 on Whatsapp "and only my homeland Ukraine is fighting for life." – It is true that we can only show solidarity from a distance and from the warm room.

Back to the **four priority aid projects** of the Soroptimists in Lviv. In addition to the generators/emergency generators, which are already urgently needed, the director of the Lychvchiky orphanage wants to further expand the center for trauma management. The continuation of dental treatment for women and children and the improvement of the living conditions of visually impaired women and children remain at the top of a long list of priorities.

Cooperation and opportunities for help in Kiev

There is also a lot of good news to report from Kiev! The **star-shaped solar lamps**, organized by us, have been delivered to the children's home in the center and thus delight many children's hearts! In addition, the Kiev SI President Maria guarantees the **support we provide for a center for trauma management for women and children!**

Help with SI clubs throughout the Ukraine

Commissioner Sina Stiffler has been maintaining contacts with the other SI clubs with great care for 13 years. As already mentioned in the news from Ukraine 8, in addition to Lviv and Kiev, SI clubs were also founded in the cities of Dnepro, later in Simferopol, Tyachev, Chernovitzi, Chernigov and Ushgorod, whereby Tiachev existed only briefly and the club Simferopol was dissolved shortly after the annexation of Crimea by Russia in 2014.

Due to the turmoil of war and other everyday worries, such as in Chernovizi, only the clubs in Lviv, Kiev, Dnepro, Chernigov and Ushgorod are active. Fortunately, Sina Stiffler is able to maintain contact with most Soroptimists. SIE commissions and supports SI Union Switzerland to continue to accompany the Ukrainian clubs.

Finances

As of December 31, 2022, we received CHF 476,000 and CHF 463,000 used for Ukraine. The Christmas campaign was also a great success!
